

Art & Crafts Info

NAME TAGS

* PAs will make the nametags prior to camp. The idea is to make them into a shape or design to identify with the name or badge of the unit (I.e. Core Staff has apple cores, Floaters have kites). A large sheet of foam should make at least eight nametags.

* Hot glue works best for holding layers together.

* Each unit will receive enough foam of the unit's level color. Amount will be determined by unit size. Daisy - Crystal Blue, Brownies - Brown, Juniors - Green, PAITs - Royal Blue, Widgets - Yellow, Outdoor Skills - lime green, Raptors - Black, Hawks - Tan. Core Staff is red

* Each unit will also receive 2 more sheets of foam, Colors of your choice.

You are not limited to three colors nor do you have to use three colors. The choice is yours. I look forward to seeing all the wonderful nametag creations you come up with this year.

* Punch holes in your nametags going through two layers of foam if possible, for strength. Gimp will be available at outdoor training to add to nametags. *******OUTDOOR SKILLS** - for safety - you should use pinned on nametags.

* On the first day of camp you will write the campers "camp name" on the nametag with a permanent marker. Please also write their real name on the back of the nametag.

ARTS & CRAFTS SUPPLY REQUISITION FORM

* A sample is in your notebook. Extras are available at Arts & Crafts.

* Only standard items are available to go to units: scissors, markers, pencils, paper, foam scraps, beads, yarn, felt, paints, Please ask if you don't see what you need on the list, we may still have it. We do not have such items as paper towel rolls, milk cartons etc. If you need these items you should contact your unit members before camp.

* Please have your Supply Request form in one day prior to when you need items. Items are on a first come first serve basis so you may have to wait for needed supplies. Bringing your own supplies from home is helpful for assuring you have what you need when you want it.

* If you know you will need items on the Monday of camp please turn in your form at Outdoor Training.

OTHER ITEMS FOR USE AT ARTS & CRAFTS AREA

Large paper cutter, rotary cutter and mat, electric pencil sharpener, long arm stapler, three-hole hole punch, two-hole hole punch and X-Acto knives.

CRAFT SCHEDULE

* Each unit has a 45 - minute session to do their craft. Please check the schedule in your notebook and note this time on your unit schedule. Leaders are required to stay unless the A&C coordinator requests you stay in order to have some extra helping hands might be needed with the craft.

* Some crafts may fill a requirement for the unit badge.

OTHER CRAFTS

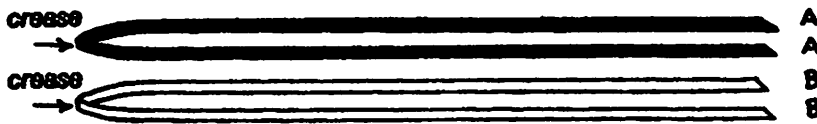
* **BIFFY** (Bathroom In the Forest For You) pins - PA's will make the biffy pins at Outdoor training or whenever they would like during camp week. Each unit member earns a biffy pin when she/he helps clean a biffy

* **SWAPS** (Some Whatchamacallit Affectionately Pinned) Here is your creative time. We will have sample swaps for you to get your imagination going. Panda also has a swap chart. Each unit is asked to bring a sample of their swap and nametag so we all can enjoy what each other has created. Individual camper swaps are also accepted.

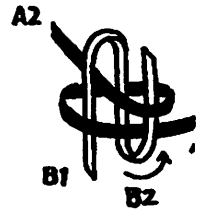
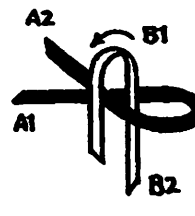
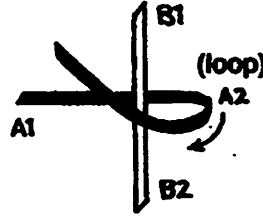
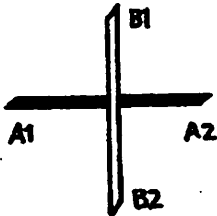
We will supply the safety pins for UNIT SWAPS ONLY at Outdoor Training. Please schedule time in your unit on Monday for making your swaps. SWAP trading begins on Tuesday. Each camper will make 10, 9 to give away and 1 to keep. A felt strip will be provided for each camper to hang their swaps from.

How to make the Box Stitch

1. You will need two different colored pieces of lace (A and B), each 6 feet long. Be sure to cut both ends of the laces at an angle.



2. Fold the laces in half. Make a crease to mark the middle of each one. (Hint: Mark the creases with a pen, if you like.)



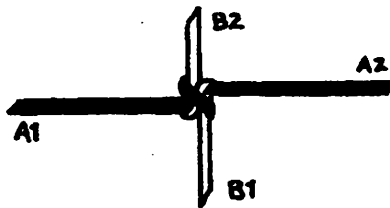
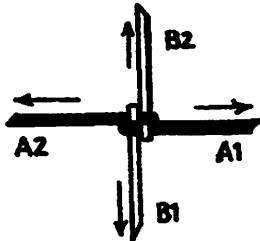
3. Put the laces together at the middle like this, with B on top of A.

Put A₂ over B₁. Leave A₂ between B₁ and A₁. Leave a loop.

Put B₁ over A₂ and A₁. Leave B₁ between A₁ and B₂.

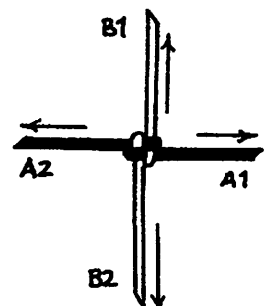
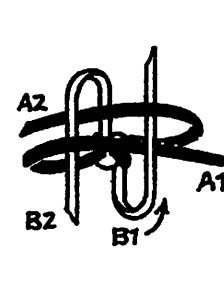
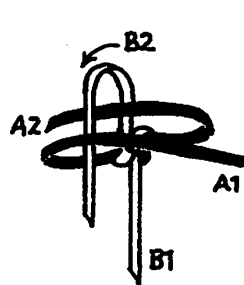
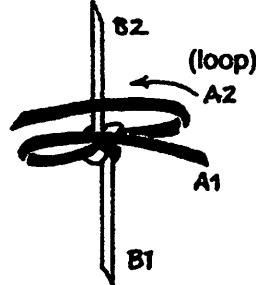
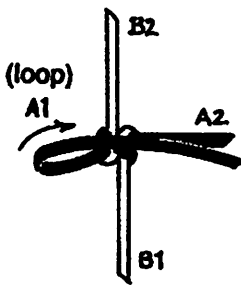
Put A₁ over B₁ and B₂.

Put B₂ over A₁ and through the loop made by A₂.



4. Pull all four ends to make a knot. It should not be too tight.

Now turn the knot over so the "X" is facing you.



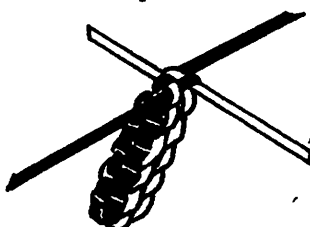
5. Loop A₁ over the middle of the knot and leave between B₁ and A₂. Leave a loop.

Loop A₂ over the middle of the knot. Leave a loop.

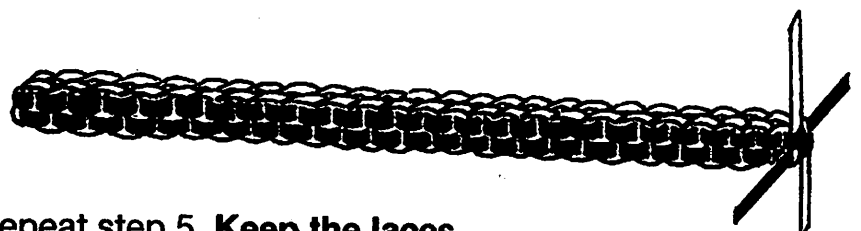
Weave B₂ over A₂ and under A₁.

Weave B₁ over A₁ and under A₂.

Pull all four ends to tighten the knot.



6. Repeat step 5. Keep the laces flat. Try not to let them twist.
